Here is a summary of information regarding China's requirement for vessel disinfections (or disinsections) as related to the Zika Virus.

Any vessel departing the U.S. en route a Chinese Port must have a "Certificate of Disinsection" stating the vessel has been treated to kill live mosquitoes, their larva, and eggs.

Note: This is a Chinese Government requirement. Chinese Port Officials will require the certificate. <u>(Note that Other</u> Links - #4 below seems to provide the clearest explanation of procedures to be carried out by port officials in Chinese ports.)
